Course Objectives:

This course is designed to help the participant gain an understanding of the 12 Core Functions, and addiction counseling competency areas applicable to LCAS, CSAC's written examination

The student will demonstrate ability to:

1. Define Dependency vs. Abuse (Signs and Symptoms)
2. Identify the major theories of addiction.
3. Recognize the major classifications of psychoactive drugs.
4. Understand behavioral patterns and progression process of drug abuse and dependency,
5. Identify intoxication, and influences of drug use including withdrawal to long term implications and treatment applications
6. Passing score on practice examinations
7. Recognize the 12 Core Functions and Competency Areas of Addiction Counseling.

Procedures for Achieving Objectives:

1. Read and discuss all material.
2. Review each chapter summary.
3. Complete weekly assignments.
4. Take scheduled practice exams.
5. Come to class on time each week.
6. Completing the registration for CSAC or LCAS

Attendance:

Participants are required to attend 100% of scheduled sessions. Participants are expected to be present at the beginning of each class time. Class will end on time. This is NCSAPPB required for supervision hours and training hours.
